Maplestead Road is a specialist service that provides housing and support for people with Mental Health support needs.

We are passionate about recovery focused, person centred support for all individuals that we support.

Maplestead Road comfortably accommodates six people in single occupancy bedrooms.

This attractive and spacious 6 bed roomed home has a large communal lounge, a kitchen diner, two bathrooms, a single toilet, and a utility/ laundry room.

Customers also enjoy the use of an established rear garden complete with a built in barbeque.

The home operates a no smoking policy for communal areas.

Daily activities

A variety of in-house activities are available as well as accessing the local community colleges and day centres and social clubs.

Support will be offered based on individual needs.

Supporting individuals

Risk management, Mental Capacity Act assessments and best interest decision making underpin our approach to supporting individuals to live their life in a meaningful way.

Core support services

- 24 hour support including night support, 7 days a week
- Support to access local community resources.
- 1:1 support hours designed with each person as required.
- Support to identify appropriate community services to meet individual needs.
- Individual person centred support plans, personal care and medication support where appropriate.
- We recognise that everybody is unique and requires different levels of support. We are able to offer additional 1:1 hours if required.
- Risk management through multi disciplinary approach.
