Hainault Road

Hainault Road is a 6 bed specialist supported living service that has recently been funded by the Department of Health to be redesigned and refurbished to positively enhance the lives of those living there.



Living at Hainault Road

The Service is based at a comfortable and homely property in Hainault Road in Waltham Forest.

With close links to community health and social work teams, our experienced and established staff team will provide a person centred service that enables people to develop independent living skills and connect with their local communities.

The Service is located close to Leytonstone High Road with a variety of shops and services as well as excellent public transport links. There are 6 large bedrooms all with modern en-suite shower facilities. The home is

fully wheelchair accessible and has lift access to the first floor and an additional platform lift to the 2nd floor.

The kitchen used by the people at the Service has rise and fall worktop. There is a spacious fully equipped utility room and a large communal living room with by fold doors that open into the large conservatory for people to relax and get together socially.

The extensive rear garden and large conservatory are enjoyed by those living at Hainault Road to be closer to nature. There is also a Wireless Nurse Call system.

Established in 1990, Outlook Care has years of experience supporting people with a learning disability.

We work in partnership with people we support, their friends and families, commissioners, care managers, health professionals, advocates and other key stakeholders.

Providing Support

We are registered with the Care Quality Commission for the personal care aspect of the service; this gives reassurance to relatives that we will continue to be monitored and regulated by an independent body.

A level of shared core support is provided to all people. A waking night facility is provided.

In addition, 1:1 support can be purchased flexibly if identified through the support planning process, based on each person's needs and wishes.

Core support services

- Availability of 24 hour support including waking night staff, 7 days a week
- Additional 1:1 support hours can be purchased to provide specific support for each person as required.
- Individual person centred support plans, personal care and medication support where required.
- Risk management through a multi disciplinary approach.
- Support to access local community resources.
- Support to identify and tap into appropriate community services to meet individual needs.
