Facilities at Hawthorn

It also has specialist bathing facilities, attractive and secure gardens and a well equipped kitchen where people can make a snack or prepare a meal. We also have a cook who prepares and serves meals daily.

We create an environment where independence and involvement are encouraged and where people have choice and control over how they live their lives.

Care and Support Planning

Support planning is led by the people we support, their circle of support and reflects a person centred approach.

Each person is allocated a named nurse and key worker.

An individualised plan of care and support will enable each person to have maximum choice and control over their lives whilst ensuring that their health and nursing needs are met.

We have excellent links with local GP services, nursing and specialist teams who work closely with us to deliver a tailor made service to each person.
