We believe in involving our customers in how we do things at Outlook Care. This is set out in our Involvement Strategy and, at our Barking and Dagenham supported living service, we were able to demonstrate our involvement in action at a very innovative recruitment day.

Rather than interview potential support workers and team leaders in our traditional way, we decided



to hold a formal interview followed by a practical session - a little like the Apprentice without the grief!

We set up various arts & crafts, cookery and music scenarios and observed how candidates engaged with customers and their families during these tasks.

Afterwards, customers and their families, together with Outlook Care staff who were involved in the process, discussed who demonstrated ability and flair for the role, which included having a great connection with the customer. Then we made the final decision on who should be appointed. We had a very successful day and now have five more person-centred members of staff.

Royal Greenwich Short Breaks

This is a unique service for people with learning disabilities. We have created a light and airy hotel-themed house, with two four-bed flats. Each flat has four en-suite bedrooms, a communal sitting area, assisted bathing facilities and communal kitchen and dining areas. The ground floor flat is fully accessible to wheelchair users and each bedroom is equipped with ceiling hoists.

Based at Kensing Road, near Westcombe Park station, our guests can take a short break lasting a few hours or a couple of weeks. They can even enjoy a pamper session and then go clubbing, all fully supervised by our staff of course.

We also provide a Short Breaks service that comes to you, because we know how important it is to have options. We can, for example, support people to take a holiday away or to get involved in local community activities. Either way, you can unwind and recharge... and a change is as good as a rest!
