At Autumn Cottage we support people with a learning disability to live independent lives.

We have seven beds available and our supported living service includes 24-hour support from an experienced staff team. You must be at least 18 years old to come and live with us.

Autumn Cottage is a supported living home for people with learning disabilities and complex needs. Our customers are supported to maintain their acquired skills and to go out into the community for activities of their choice. We are situated in a wonderful location near the sea and we have many attractions in the area that customers enjoy.

### Services provided

- Individual enhanced hours. Fees are based on assessment of need for each individual at a competitive rate.
- Individual person-centred support plans, personal care and medication support where appropriate.
